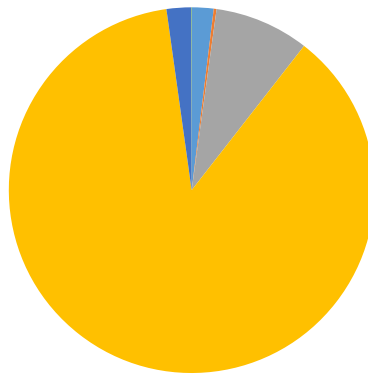

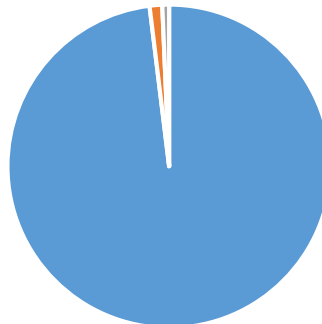
Revenue

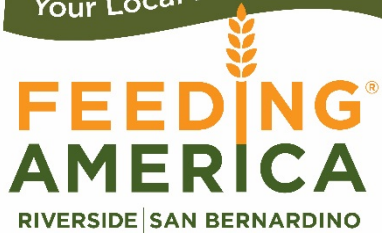
