#### **Reason for Need**



There is not a single person who wants to be "in need" of food or who enjoys it. People come to FARSB for many reasons.

Some single parents didn't choose to be a single parent with three hungry children. They chose to be a family with two loving parents, equally sharing the joy of raising a family and seeking happiness, but they unexpectedly lost their mate. They have lost half of their childcare and sometimes the majority of their income. If they are lucky they continue using what little savings they have while receiving help from family and friends, but that, too, eventually runs out.

These are hardworking, responsible people who love and care for their children just like you and I care about ours. They just need relief to get by until their situation changes. They don't ask for food forever-- just this month so they have enough to get by until their work situation changes or until they get a new job.

Older couples that have raised their children are now juggling finances due to the high cost of living and health care expenses. They didn't expect that they, too, would need food. They didn't plan on a sudden illness wiping out their bank account, but they still need help until they sell their home and move somewhere more affordable.

Affluent families have suddenly lost their job or were furloughed. Just a box or two of food until their paycheck resumes is all that all they ask for.

People seek assistance for a day, a month, and sometimes longer. They didn't choose the path they are on, life chose it for them. It happens. It has happened to me and that's why I am here to help, that's why I love my job, and why I choose to work here.

FARSB opened in 1980 as Survive Food Bank in response to the increasing concern about the dual problems of hunger and food waste in the Inland Empire. Today, FARSB is the primary source of food for over 200 local nonprofit organizations, distributing over 2 million pounds of food monthly to emergency food pantries, homeless shelters, soup kitchens, high-need elementary schools, halfway houses, senior centers, residential treatment centers, shelters for the abused, after school programs and group homes. With the help of these charity partners, we make up the largest hunger relief organization in the Inland Empire, making food security a reality for over 1.2 million people every year. FARSB is leading the fight against hunger in the Inland Empire by providing food access, emergency relief, education, and advocacy to families in Riverside and San Bernardino Counties.
